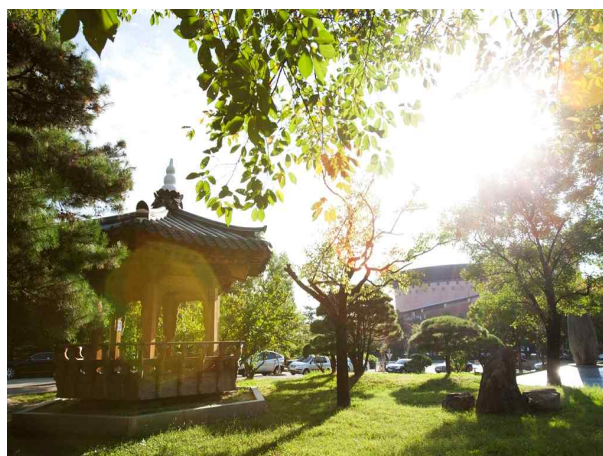

## 3 Eligibility and Requirements

### A. Citizenship/Academic Requirements

1) **Freshman (first year) student** : Applicant must meet one of the following requirements

A) **A non-Korean citizen applicant with non-Korean citizen parents**, who has completed (or is expected to complete) regular high school/secondary education in Korea or overseas.

※ Holders of dual citizenship –one of which is Korean citizenship– can NOT apply as an International student.

B) **A non-Korean citizen applicant** who has completed regular primary and secondary education overseas. (Nationality of the applicant's parents does not matter.)

2) **Transfer Student** : Applicant must meet one of the following requirements

A) **A non-Korean citizen applicant with non-Korean citizen parents**, who has an academic record of minimum two years(4 semesters) completed in an undergraduate program at a regular four year university in Korea or overseas.

B) **A non-Korean citizen applicant** who has completed regular primary and secondary education overseas and has an academic record of minimum two years(4 semesters) in an undergraduate program at a regular four year university outside of Korea. (Nationality of the applicant's parents does not matter.)

※ In case of two or three year college, only those who have graduated (or are expected to graduate) can apply as transfer student.

※ Applicant who has an academic record of minimum one year can apply for transfer to sophomore.

**B. Language Proficiency Requirements** : Applicants who meet one of the following requirements

1) **All** (except for Jimmy Carter School of International Studies)

A) Applicant with Test of Proficiency in Korean **TOPIK Level 3** or above.

B) Applicant who has completed **Korean class Level 4** at the Korean Language Education Center in Korea.

C) Applicant for the College of Arts(except for Industrial Design) may apply without the above mentioned language proficiency if they are capable of **taking classes in Korean**.

**※ Notes about Korean Language Proficiency**

- ▶ It is valid only if the student passed the application recognition score.
- ▶ If applicants do not have Korean Language Proficiency when they apply, they can submit a Certificate of TOPIK Examination or a Certificate of Enrollment for Korean Language Center. After that, the applicants must submit the document for **TOPIK Level 3(or above) result by Feb 2, 2017(Thu)** or **Certificate of Korean Language Center Completion Level 4(or above) by Feb 22, 2017(Wed)**. Failure to do so will result in automatic disqualification.
- ▶ Class Registration based on TOPIK Level
  - TOPIK Level 3 or below : it can take up to 12 credits
  - TOPIK Level 4 or above : it can take up to maximum credits
- ▶ Once admitted, students must attain **TOPIK Level 4** or above before a graduation.

**2) Jimmy Carter School of International Studies**

- A) Applicant with Test of Proficiency in English **TOEFL(CBT 210, iBT 80), IELTS 5.5, TEPS 550** or above.
- B) Applicant who has completed regular secondary or higher education in countries where English is the primary language of education.  
(Ex. U.S.A, Canada, England, Australia and Republic of South Africa)
- C) Applicant from a non-native English countries but has completed the education from an institute where the primary language of education is English.
  - ※ Must submit a proof document showing the primary language of education is English.  
(ex. Principal's confirmation)

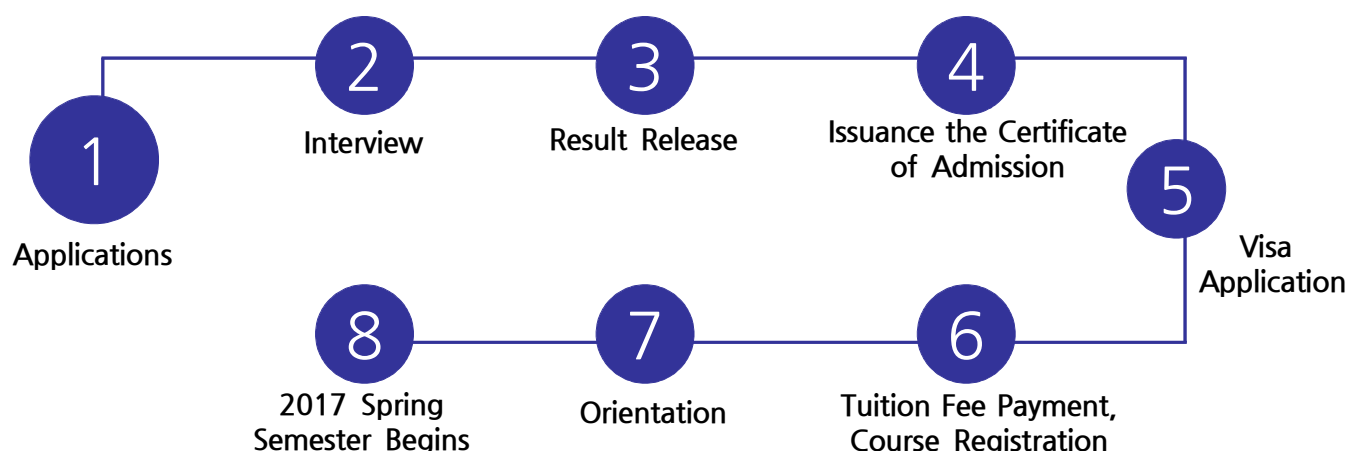


## B. Admission Criteria : Document Screening and Interview

- 1) Document screening : Office of International Cooperation examines whether or not the applications contain all necessary documents specified on the guideline.
- 2) Interview: Each department conducts the interview (Overseas residents may have a phone-interview after receiving a notification by the appropriate department.

(Swift Code : JEONKRSE)
- ※ Sender's Name must be the same as the applicant's name and after remitting the fee, the applicant must send the application fee receipt.
- ※ Application may be rescinded when the application fee payment can not be confirmed by the deadline.

- 1) **Certificate of Diploma Verification** (one of the following documents)
  - A) **Apostille**
  - B) **Consular Confirmation** at the Korean Embassy in your homeland or the Embassy of your country located in Korea
  - C) **Chinese Applicants : 高考 Records** must be submitted as a certified report in English issued by CHSI(学信网, [www.chsi.com.cn](http://www.chsi.com.cn)) or CDGDC(学位网, [www.cdgdc.edu.cn](http://www.cdgdc.edu.cn)).
  - Procedure : Online Application ⇨ Printout the Application and Submit the documents ⇨ Payment ⇨ Authorized Judgement(20 days) ⇨ Issue the Certificate
  - ※ If an issue of the verification is not yet completed at the time of applying, applicant must submit copy of diploma and proof of application along with other required documents. After that, applicant must submit the original diploma and verification **by Feb 3, 2017(Fri)**.
  - ※ **After release the result, the successful applicant must submit additional document as original, otherwise the Certificate of Admission will not be issued.**

## 6 Note for Applicants

### A. Important Notes for Submission

- 1) Write down the exact name of the department applied for in Korean or English and changing of majors is not allowed once the application has been accepted.
- 2) All required documents must be original documents. If originals cannot be submitted, copies can be submitted but they must have been certified as true copies of the original by the relevant organization/institution or the Office of International Cooperation at Chonbuk National University upon submission.
- 3) **All documents must be in Korean or English. Any documents written in a language other than Korean or English must be translated into Korean or English.**
- 4) All applications must contain all the required documents and are to be completed before the deadline. Only the application that met the deadline is acceptable when you apply via mail.
- 5) CBNU is not responsible for admission cancellation due to the mistakes made on the application, missing documents, and unfulfilled entry procedures.
- 6) If any of the application documents contain false information or forgery, admission will be cancelled

immediately. Also, if the applicant is found to be not fully eligible for the requirement, admission may also be rescinded even after the admission has been granted. In this case, tuition fee is non-refundable. Furthermore they cannot apply for Chonbuk National University for next 3 years.

- 7) Admitted applicant who is an expected graduate or still attending school/university/college at the time of the application submission must submit a Certificate of Completion or Diploma to the OIC, CBNU by **Feb 3, 2017(Fri)**, otherwise their admission may be withdrawn.
- 8) All documents are not to be stapled.
- 9) All documents must be in size A4 format, if not it should be pasted on an A4 sized paper.

## B. Important Notes for All Applicants

- 1) Applicant must always follow instructions from the 'Notice Board(학사공지)' on the CBNU website.
- 2) A non-Korean citizen applicant with Korean citizen parents can apply to CBNU up to a maximum of six times per year regardless of the type or rounds of screening you one applied for. Any applicant who has violated this will be disadvantaged and have one's application withdrawn by the university.
- 3) Following applicant may be **Denied or Disqualified for Admission**.
  - A) Applicant who fail to pay their tuition fee before the designated deadline.
  - B) Applicant who is enrolled in two or more universities on the same semester.
- 4) Evaluation scores for admission will not be disclosed.
- 5) All the information including admission announcements will be posted on the homepage so applicant must follow the directions carefully.
- 6) **The most accurate and frequently used contact telephone number and email address must be provided** so that applicant can be reached immediately in case of emergency. CBNU is not responsible for not being able to reach the applicant because of the wrong contact details provided by the applicant in the application form. **(Yahoo, Hotmail, Sina E-mail servers are unavailable)**
- 7) All the submitted documents and application fee a will not be refunded nor be returned.
  - ※ The original Certificate of Graduation and the Household Register(Hukoubu) from Chinese applicants will be returned after all entrance procedures are completed.
- 8) Regulations of CBNU are applied to the items that are not defined on this prospectus and other particulars are decided by the Committee of Admission Screening for International Students.

## 7 Visa Application Guide for Admitted Students

A. Certificate of Admission will be issued to the final successful applicants.

B. How to Student VISA(D-2) : at the Office of International Cooperation(OIC), CBNU

- 1) Korean Resident : Prepare the required documents and visit OIC
  - 2) Overseas resident : OIC will send a 'Confirmation of Visa issuance' and a 'Certificate of Business registration' to the successful applicant ⇒ Visit Korean embassy in your own country with visa certified number and required documents\* ⇒ After enter Korea, apply Alien Card at OIC, CBNU
- \* You can check these at the website at the Korean Embassy in your homeland.

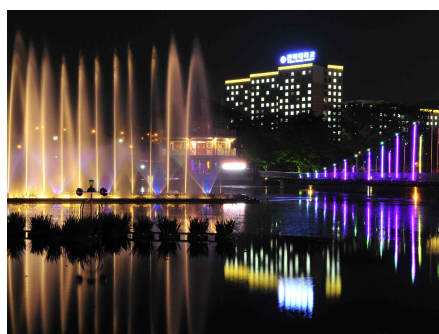
### C. Application : Made at the time of application for admission

- 1) All International students can stay at the dormitory. Dormitory application will be cancelled automatically if applicant do not make payments for the dormitory fee by the deadline.
- 2) In such a case that you want to withdraw the application to dormitory, you have inform to either the Office of International Cooperation or the Office of the Dormitory by Feb 24, 2017(Fri). You will be charged for the dormitory fee if you cancel the application after semester begins.
